Information Notice

The Mexican Caribbean is operating normally.

All four international airports in the state, as well as ports, cruise terminals, hotels, and tourism services, continue to function without disruptions.

The isolated incidents recorded in the state were promptly addressed by authorities and did not represent any risk to our visitors or tourists at any time.

Under the leadership of Governor Mara Lezama, Quintana Roo maintains active tourism security protocols in coordination with federal, state, and local authorities, ensuring stability and continuous attention in high-traffic areas.

Regarding the travel advisory issued by the United States, we reiterate that tourism operations across the state remain stable and unaffected.
